New partnership will honor top teachers at Jacksonville Jaguars game December 24

This is the first year in which the Jacksonville Jaguars will host a Teacher Appreciation Game. In addition to the Teacher of the Year nominees receiving tickets, the 15 district semifinalists will be honored with an on-field presentation during the game.

As part of the celebration, all Duval County Public Schools teachers and employees will have the opportunity to purchase discounted tickets to the Dec. 24 home game versus the Tennessee Titans.

"Teachers are the true MVPs," Chad Johnson, senior vice president of sales and service for the Jaguars, said. "We look forward to hosting them at EverBank Field for our Teacher Appreciation Game and recognizing their outstanding work."
