A green infrastructure/community garden project funded and constructed jointly by Deutsche Bank, LISC NYC, Rebuilding Together NYC and Banana Kelly CIA, Inc.

Join us on Thursday, May 19th at 9:30 AM, for the Kick-off event for the construction of the 331 E. 146th Street Garden, a green infrastructure/community garden project funded and constructed jointly by The Residents of 331 E. 146th Street, Deutsche Bank, LISC NYC, Rebuilding Together NYC and Banana Kelly Community Improvement Association, Inc. This garden, one of the South Bronx's rare residential gardens, will provide a beautifully designed and inviting open space for the residents of the building and the wider community. The building and surrounding neighborhood is home to many families with small children. The garden and open space, which will contain planting beds and large area for gatherings, will allow for a unique space for the expanding of the building's children reading group and provide the space for BBQ's, Holiday events, tenant association meetings, and other neighborhood gatherings. The garden's growing areas will also be used to host food and nutrition workshops and provide freshly grown vegetables to a population that currently has limited access to fresh foods. According to Wanda Swinney, Resident Council member and 331 E 146th Tenant Association founder, "*We are working together to transform our community together and we are starting with this building by providing a safe space for people to come together, have fun, and build community."*
